You may check in a half hour before you are scheduled to run. You will have to trot your your dog. Females will be wiped to check for heat cycle. This will be done for dogs that are spayed. Per AKC rules. At check in you will be given a ticket with name and number. You will have to provide this to the entry gate to run. If running a second time you will have to repeat the process.

Prizes

A flat blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

Rosettes to dogs completing titles BCAT, DCAT or FCAT, as available (at least one will be available for a picture and we will mail a rosette if we run out). Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you anticipate completing a title. The fastest Bearded Collie will receive an Elitefield Crate and rosette. The Fastest Veteran Bearded Collie will receive a crate cover and rosette. The slowest Bearded Collie will receive the Turtle Award along with a large stuffed turtle and rosette.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration. or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program on the day of the trial. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

Dogs may only run once per test. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry

What is FastCAT?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- 2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- 3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).
- 4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

5. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

6. Titles are earned at specific point levels BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

*ACCORDING TO AKC RULES; Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only.

Trial Information

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Please bring 2 leashes. One to release the dog. One to catch the dog.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water. Shade tents, crates,

- etc. may be left overnight at owner's risk.
- Kiddie pools will be available for use during the event
- An electric and electronic timing system will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be marked off with snow fencing.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Any dog that eliminates on course or in the run-out area while the timer is running will receive a nonqualifying (NQ) score.
- Muzzles are allowed. No pinch collars, and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed. The club recommends using a plain buckle collar and lead. No flexi leads will be allowed for safety reasons.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded only if they show up to the event and are excused.
- The Hunt master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/CCDAC/DDOM/ dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- The event-hosting club, Bearded Collie Club of America, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
